From 1980 through December, 2013, Oracle Editors were Board Members. The Editors are listed in a separate chart. (Note: in 2011 a bylaws amendment provided that an Editor could serve for more than two consecutive years and also could choose whether to be a Board Member, but not for more than two consecutive years. A 2013 bylaws amendment created the position of Communications Officer to be the Board's liaison with the Editor and Webmaster.)

In 2004, a Bylaws amendment changed the position of Past President to Parliamentarian (who typically is the immediate past President).
